Lessons are held at Southport College, **Pennington Building, Mornington Rd.** Mon- Fri at 9am until 12.30 with a break between 11.00 and 11.30. Toilets are on the first floor for boys and second floor for girls. Please do not take toilet breaks during the lessons.

Remember your travel pass every day- you may need it in the afternoons!

Half day excursions depart at 1pm, Full day excursions at 9am. (see below for any variations) Train excursions will leave from Southport station

Please remember your packed lunch every day, including Saturdays and departure day. Lunches can be eaten in the refectory in the main college building, but only in areas for students, and yellow LANYARDS must be worn for access to this area. Please respect this area and tidy up afterwards.

AUG 16	Thursday	You will be met outside the Pennington Building Entrance. At 9.00 teachers will meet you and take you to the Welcome Meeting. You will then take a written English test to determine which class level will be best for you followed by a half hour break. Introduction and safety lessons followed by lunch break. After lunch in the refectory (remember to wear your lanyard at all times) you will have Orientation of Southport. Meet inside the refectory at 1.30 and an afternoon supervisor will meet with your group and take you around the town centre and point out places of importance. Your Host family will meet you back at the college, Pennington Building for 4.30pm Evening activity - Disco in the Balmoral Suite, Royal Clifton Hotel, Promenade (8-10)
AUG 17	Friday	English lessons followed by a visit to the Southport Flower show
AUG 18	Saturday	Full day excursion to Chester (9- 6) You will travel to Chester by train with your Supervisor. (approx 1 ½ hours) On arrival you will walk into the City centre viewing the ancient ruins and beautiful old buildings. You will play the Mobile Phone Quiz and still have free time for shopping or a walk on the walls. Remember to be at the meeting point at the right time to take the train at 16.00.
AUG 19	Sunday	Host family day – please talk with your host family about plans for the day
AUG 20	Monday	English lessons followed by Photo Trail/Quiz in Churchtown. Try to find answers to questions about this beautiful village! Meet at the monument at 1.30 with supervisors. You will take a bus there (remember your travel pass today!) and return around 4pm
AUG 21	Tuesday	English lessons followed by Mini golf at 2pm Meet supervisors at the Monument at 1.30, and later take the Lord Street Photo Trail in Southport and see who can get all the answers to the quiz sheet correct and win a prize!

AUG 22	Wednesday	English lessons followed by indoor games afternoon Evening activity - Bowling. (Don't forget your socks!) Meet at the bowling alley (19.45) where you will hand over your shoes for a pair of bowling shoes. Each lane can take 6 persons, so decide who you want to play with and your game will start at 8pm and finish at 9pm.
AUG 23	Thursday	English lessons followed by an excursion to Liverpool by train. Meet your supervisor to take the 12.44 train from Southport station and travel to the city where you will travel on the famous Liverpool ferry across the Mersey - take photos of the waterfront. Some free time for shopping before taking the train to return to Southport for 6pm
AUG 24	Friday	English lessons followed by Certificate and prize-giving then have a visit to Splashworld. Remember your swimming costume and towel! Meet supervisors at the Monument at 1.15. You will walk to Splashworld to experience the new indoor water park with the Speed Freak ride or the Lazy River Tyre ride! Or if you prefer not to swim- just tell your teacher and attend another activity
AUG 25	Saturday	Full day excursion to Manchester* (9 – 6) Meet inside Southport Station by the barriers at 9am Visit the Museum of Science and Industry. See full sized planes and walk through sewers!! Have your lunch before walking to the shopping centre. You will have free time before taking the train back to Southport for approximately 6pm
AUG 26	Sunday	Host family day – please talk with your host family about plans for the day
AUG 27	Monday BANK HOLIDAY	Full day excursion to Liverpool <u>DEPARTING 10AM</u> You will visit the famous 2 cathedrals, and Chinese Arch, then visit the World Museum. There will be some free time for shopping before meeting to travel back on the 16.53 train to Southport. (Arrive 17.38)
AUG 28	Tuesday	Departure of your group. Remember your packed meal and meet at the station for 07.30
