19 th July	Thursday	English test and lessons followed by Orientation of Liverpool. Return to Clarence Street for 4pm for collection by Host Families If your family makes other arrangements your host family will give you a note so your Leader can understand.
20 th July	Friday	English lessons followed by a photo trail then free time.
21 st July	Saturday	Full day excursion to Manchester* (9 – 6) Meet at Central station at Visit the Museum of Science and Industry. See full sized planes and walk through sewers!! Have your lunch before walking to the shopping centre. You will have free time before taking the train back to Liverpool for approximately 6pm
22 nd July	Sunday	Host family day – please talk with your host family about plans for the day
23 rd July	Monday	English lessons followed by a visit to Crosby beach to see the Iron Men and play beach games (Volleyball or Baseball) or have a Sandcastle competition.
24 th July	Tuesday	English lessons followed by a visit to the Albert Dock and Museums Evening activity - Plaza Cinema Waterloo. Students are to meet at Waterloo station at 7.20pm
25 th July	Wednesday	English lessons followed by afternoon excursion to Chester (1-6) You will travel to Chester by train with your Supervisor. (approx 45 minutes) On arrival you will walk into the City centre viewing the ancient ruins and beautiful old buildings. You will play the Mobile Phone Quiz and then have free time for shopping. Remember to be at the meeting point at the right time. Arrive in Liverpool at approximately 6pm
