15 <sup>th</sup> April	Sunday	Arrival of your group.
16 <sup>th</sup> April	Monday	English lessons followed by Orientation and some free time. Meet with your afternoon supervisor at 1.30 and they will take you around the town centre and point out places of importance. You will finish at the Temperance Institute for 4.30pm. Your Host family will meet you there unless they have arranged another time and place - they will give you a note.
17 <sup>th</sup> April	Tuesday	English lessons followed by an afternoon excursion to Liverpool by train. You will explore the Beatles Cavern and Matthew Street and enjoy a ferry ride across the River Mersey and take amazing photos of the Liverpool skyline and beautiful buildings. There will be some free time for shopping before meeting to travel back on the train to Southport.
18 <sup>th</sup> April	Wednesday	English lessons followed by the Photo Trail in Southport. Meet supervisors at the Monument at 1.30, and see who can get all the answers to the quiz sheet correct and win a prize! Collect another quiz sheet and set off in the opposite direction. Who will you want in your team of 3 of 4?  Evening activity - Ten pin bowling. Meet inside Premier bowl at Ocean plaza at 7.45 where you will hand over your shoes for a pair of bowling shoes. (Remember to wear socks!!) Your game will start at 8pm and finish at 9pm.
19 <sup>th</sup> April	Thursday	English lessons followed by an afternoon excursion to Liverpool by train. You will visit the Liverpool museum and Albert Dock. There will be some free time for shopping before meeting to travel back on the train to Southport.
20 <sup>th</sup> April	Friday	<b>** Remember to bring your SNCF train pass today**</b> Full day excursion to Chester. Meet inside Southport Station by the barriers before 9am. You will travel to Chester by train with your Supervisor. (approx 1 ½ hours) On arrival you will walk into the City centre viewing the ancient ruins and beautiful old buildings. You will play the Mobile Phone Quiz and then have free time for shopping. Remember to be at the meeting point in time for the train departing at 4pm Return approximately 6pm
21 <sup>st</sup>	Saturday	<b>** Remember to bring your SNCF travel pass today**</b>

April		Full day excursion to Manchester (9 – 6) Meet your supervisor by the ticket barrier to take the 9.24 train. Visit the Museum of Science and Industry. See full-sized planes and walk through sewers!! Have your lunch before walking to the shopping centre. You will have free time before taking the train at 16.22, arriving in Southport at 17.37
22 <sup>nd</sup> April	Sunday	Departure of your group 06.45 (by coach) at B&Q car park. Remember your packed lunch.
